OUR PROPOSED PLANS

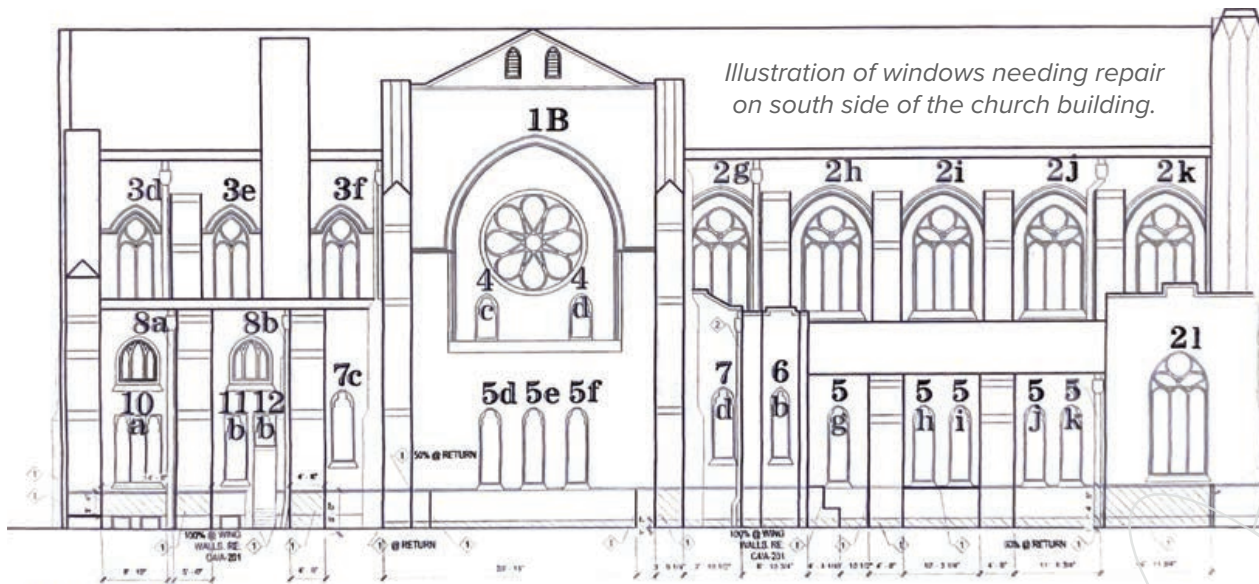


RESTORE WINDOWS & INSTALL NEW COOLING SYSTEM | \$7.1 MILLION

Our church building is one of our parish's greatest ambassadors to the Denver community. Its iconic visuals – including the grand windows – draw people in. The deteriorating state of the windows, though, detracts from this presentation. We can enhance the beauty, functionality and comfort of our church by restoring the windows. This work, as well as a new mechanical cooling system, will ensure the health and comfort of our parishioners, especially during hot summers, enhance the prayerful experience during Mass and reduce energy costs.

RENOVATE BASEMENT | \$800,000

We want to create a more functional and inviting space for community events and programs by upgrading the kitchen, bathrooms, partitions, storage and lighting. Addressing these spaces and needs now will prevent further deterioration and provide much-needed space for faith formation and community-building activities, promoting a vibrant parish life.



REPAIR & UPGRADE CHURCH BUILDING | \$2.16 MILLION

We can create a more welcoming environment and support the parish's mission of engaging the community by enhancing the church's aesthetic appeal and functionality. Interior work includes cleaning and repairing plaster, upgrading lighting and ceiling fans, and painting. Exterior work includes cleaning and repairing stone, fixing steps, improving drainage and gutter systems, and adding a handicap ramp.



IMPROVE OUR CAMPUS | \$372,000

Creating a more beautiful and functional outdoor space will foster a sense of community and vitality among our parishioners. We want to renovate the patio between the church and parish center, as well as repair and light the south parking lot.
