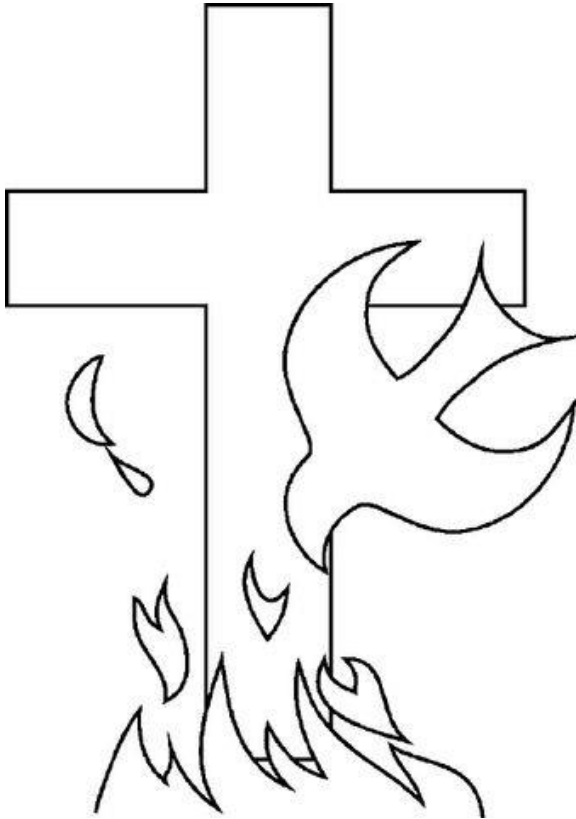

so also Christ.

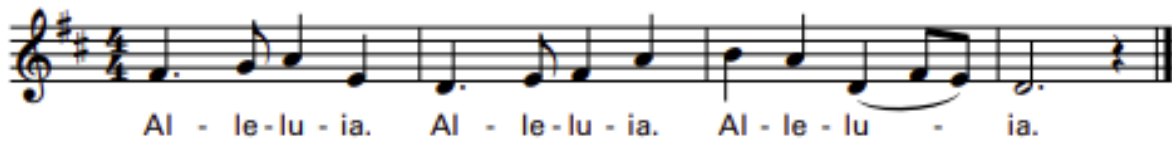
