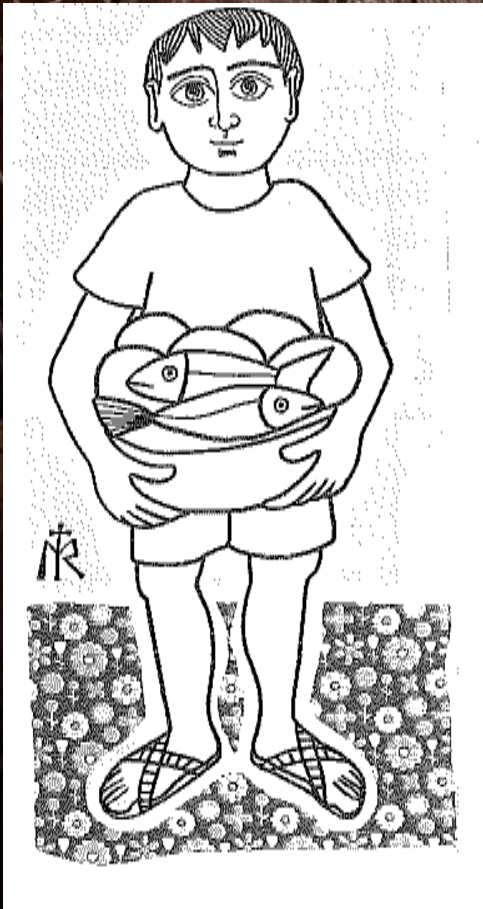

PASTORAL REFLECTIONS / REFLEXIONES PASTORALES

Did you know that Jesus wasn't the first to multiply loaves of bread to feed many? Read the 1st reading for this Sunday again! 2 Kgs 4:42-44 is a story where Elisha does the same thing! Though Elisha had 20 loaves for 100 people, and Jesus only had 5 loaves for 5,000 people. Jesus wins!

Listen to how the people reacted, "This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world." Those around Jesus saw the same works God has performed many times before through the prophets: like Moses in the desert and Elisha before the 100. In this instance, God feeds his people not only with bread for their bellies, but with the relief to see this work of God before their very eyes, the same work they knew of in the stories they heard growing up, as if to give them a sense of calm, security, and joy to know that their LORD is still with them tending to their needs.

The who, when, how and where our deepest needs are met are unpredictable and uncontrollable, for God works in SO many ways: through others, miracles, Sacraments, hidden angels, obvious signs. But as the Body, as Paul so beautifully reminds us this weekend, is diverse in its unity and united in its diversity, so too does God employ a variety of ways to make sure the body is fed as a whole.

One way I truly believe our St. Dominic Body is fed is through the generous service of our own who are part of our Pastoral Council. We will be having elections at the end of August, and starting next week, we will be opening up the floor for nominations. The Council helps inform me, as Pastor, of what's going on in the life of the Parish and the lives of its people, gives thoughtful advice and insight on the history, current state, and future of the Parish, as well as encourages action, assists in helping me make decisions, offers constructive criticism, and walks with me in loving all who come to our Parish hungry and in need (in all possible human ways).

Please consider throwing your hat in the ring, to serve the Parish in helping me as Pastor to guide and shepherd you all.

¿Sabías que Jesús no fue el primero en multiplicar los panes para alimentar a muchos? Vuelve a leer la primera lectura de este domingo. 2 Reyes 4:42-44 es una historia en la que Eliseo hace lo mismo. Aunque Eliseo tenía 20 panes para 100 personas, y Jesús sólo tenía 5 panes para 5.000 personas. ¡Jesús gana!

Escucha cómo reaccionó la gente: "Éste es, en verdad, el profeta que habría de venir al mundo". Los que rodeaban a Jesús vieron las mismas obras que Dios ha realizado muchas veces antes a través de los profetas: como Moisés en el desierto y Eliseo ante los 100. En este caso, Dios alimenta a su pueblo no sólo con pan para sus estómagos, sino con el alivio de ver esta obra de Dios ante sus propios ojos, la misma obra que conocieron en las historias que escucharon mientras crecían, como para darles una sensación de calma, seguridad y alegría al saber que su SEÑOR sigue con ellos atendiendo sus necesidades.

El quién, el cuándo, el cómo y el dónde se satisfacen nuestras necesidades más profundas son imprevisibles e incontrolables, porque Dios actúa de MUCHAS maneras: a través de otros, de milagros, de sacramentos, de ángeles ocultos, de signos evidentes. Pero como el Cuerpo, como Pablo nos recuerda tan bellamente este fin de semana, es diverso en su unidad y unido en su diversidad, así también Dios emplea una variedad de maneras para asegurarse de que el cuerpo sea alimentado como un todo.
